2025 Civil Legal Aid Grantees

In 2025, NC IOLTA will distribute nearly \$12 million in grants to 35 nonprofits across the state. Ninety-three percent of those funds — more than \$11 million — supports Civil Legal Aid Grants, which provide basic access to the justice system for individuals, families and children residing in every county in North Carolina.

Inner Banks Legal Services

\$110,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports legal services in the area of family law.

International House of Metrolina

\$55,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports the Immigration Law Clinic.

JusticeMatters

\$240,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports advocacy for survivors of human trafficking. JusticeMatters also received a system support grant for organizational capacity building.

Land Loss Prevention Project

\$100,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports advocacy for family farmers and landowners.

Legal Aid of North Carolina

\$5,325,000 Civil Legal Aid Grants support programs including domestic violence, education, employment, health care, housing, public benefits and seniors. LANC also received a grant to support access to legal aid for rural communities and a system support grant for technology upgrades.

National Health Law Program (NHeLP)

\$50,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports legal assistance related to health care access.

North Carolina Equal Access to Justice Commission

\$160,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports the Pro Bono Resource Center.

North Carolina Equal Justice Alliance

\$124,952 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports operating expenses.

North Carolina Justice Center

\$ 1,070,000 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports the litigation team. The Justice Center also received a system support grant for technology upgrades.

North Carolina Prisoner Legal Services

\$66,500 Civil Legal Aid Grant supports the Safe and Humane Jails Project. NCPLS also received a system support grant for organizational capacity building.

Pisgah Legal Services

\$1,160,000 Civil Legal Aid Grants support programs including children's law, domestic violence prevention, expunctions, health care, housing and more. PLS also received a system support grant for organizational capacity building.
